

2010 Season Pass Guidelines

These rules and guidelines are defined for the safety, welfare, and enjoyment of all persons purchasing and using Surfside's season passes. Surfside will make every reasonable effort to enforce the following rules and regulations, but makes no representation or guarantees that it will be able to cite every violator.

1. **OUTSIDE FOOD AND DRINKS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PARK.**
2. **THIS SEASON PASS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED WITH PAYMENT** to receive your personalized season pass to Surfside for the 2010-operating season. Please make sure all information on this form is filled out correctly and completely.
3. The pass is **NON-REFUNDABLE** and **NON-TRANSFERRABLE**. The season pass remains property of Surfside and may be **REVOKED** temporarily or permanently if any of the rules and guidelines are violated. Should you move or be unable to visit Surfside for any other reason during the 2010 operating season, **NO REFUNDS OR TRANSFERS WILL BE MADE.** _____ (Passholder initials) _____ (Surfside initials)
4. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR PHOTO ID PASS WITH YOU TO ENTER THE PARK.** For security purposes, we do not offer a one-time look up in our database. Present your Surfside season pass at the designated gate each day you visit the park. Additional identification may be required. Unauthorized use of a season pass is a criminal offense and will be prosecuted to the fullest extent. Season passes are valid for use by the person pictured on the pass **ONLY**. If any person except the owner attempts use, the pass will be revoked without refund.
5. **SURFSIDE IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR A LOST OR STOLEN SEASON PASS.** Please use a locker or take other appropriate measures to avoid theft. In the event of a lost or stolen season pass, you must report the loss to the Surfside Office where you may purchase a replacement pass for \$20 plus tax. Proper identification is required to purchase a replacement. Only one replacement pass per person will be issued during the 2010-operating season. Please secure your season pass card to avoid loss.
6. Your Surfside season pass is **NOT VALID** for special promotions and events.
7. **DUE TO CAPACITY LIMITATIONS** and for the safety of our Guests, management reserves the right to decline admission while park is at capacity levels.
8. **SURFSIDE IS A NON-ALCOHOL FACILITY.**
9. **YOUR SURFSIDE SEASON PASS IS VALID** during regular park operating hours of the 2010 season.
10. Season pass holders are not eligible for rain checks.
11. **SURFSIDE SEASON PASS GUIDELINES AND SCHEDULES** are subject to change without notice.
12. **NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 13 YEARS IS PERMITTED IN THE PARK WITHOUT AN ADULT.**
13. **SURFSIDE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE ANY SEASON PASS WITHOUT REFUND FOR:**
 - A. Violation of park rules and/or safety procedures and regulations as posted throughout the park.
 - B. Assisting another person in any way to obtain unauthorized entry to Surfside.
 - C. Any violation of federal, state, or local laws while at Surfside.
 - D. Any conduct deemed by Surfside Management to interfere with the safety or enjoyment of other guest.
 - E. Entry into Surfside before or after park operating hours.
14. **NO FOOD OR DRINK IS ALLOWED INSIDE THE PARK.**
15. **YOU ARE PARTICIPATING AT YOUR OWN RISK.**
